I asked God why you and not me? He said, "because I didn't want you, I wanted Barry".

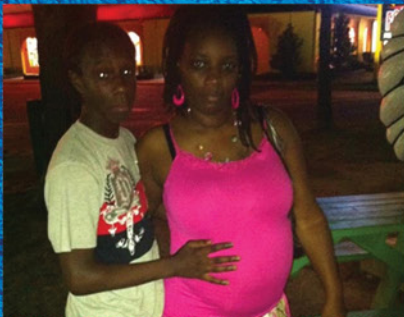
About this one right here, I can go on and on, but I won't argue with God, just make sure he's good in his new home.

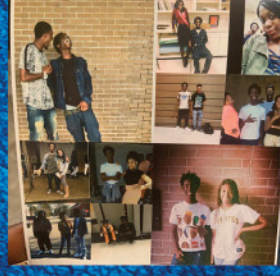
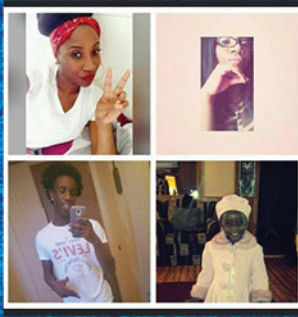
When I lost you, I lost a big part of me. What was done to you, I wouldn't put it on my worst enemy.
