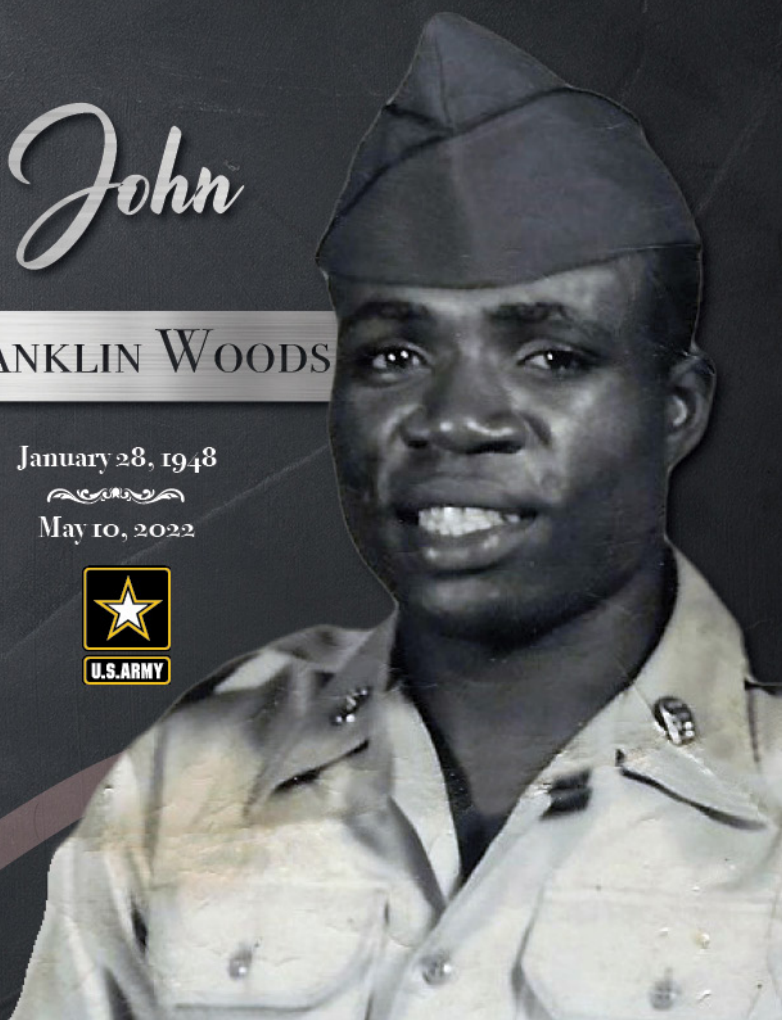
John
